Daniel 6:25-27 “Then king Darius wrote unto all people, nations, and languages, that dwell in all the earth; Peace be multiplied unto you. I make a decree, That in every dominion of my kingdom men tremble and fear before the God of Daniel: for he *is* the living God, and stedfast for ever, and his kingdom *that* which shall not be destroyed, and his dominion *shall be even* unto the end. He delivereth and rescueth, and he worketh signs and wonders in heaven and in earth, who hath delivered Daniel from the power of the lions.” Here we have an observation made by a heathen king Darius about a man named Daniel who had just been rescued from a den of lions. Darius was bringing attention to the one who had indeed rescued Daniel and that was God. His name is Jesus. Jesus rescues!

When you are lonely...Jesus rescues! Psalm 27:10 “When my father and my mother forsake me, then the LORD will take me up.” When we are feeling lonely we need someone to take us up and hold us and let us know they are with us. Jesus does just that. Time and time again in the Bible we read of those that were lonely or had gone astray and Jesus was with them in their times of loneliness. In Hebrews 13:5 we are promised that Jesus “...will never leave thee, nor forsake thee.” Has that ever been your experience?

When you worry...Jesus rescues! Psalm 34:19 “Many *are* the afflictions of the righteous: but the LORD delivereth him out of them all.” Now in Acts 12 we find the account of Peter in a conversation with an angel sent by God to bring him out of prison. Notice that there were things that Peter could do (put on his shoes and gird himself). There were things Peter couldn't do, like make professional soldiers who were on watch fail to see Peter escaping or open locked gates and door. This is a wonderful lesson in life. We are to do the things we can do (pray, study God's word, seek to worship God). And there are things we can't do that are going to require divine power. In those cases don't worry, put your cares into the hands of God.

When you struggle...Jesus rescues! Psalm 46:10 “Be still, and know that I *am* God: I will be exalted among the heathen, I will be exalted in the earth.” Many in the Bible struggled in their life, Joseph for one. Most of his life was a struggle to survive trials and tribulations and yet God rescued him by taking things that looked bad to us and turning them into good.

When you're powerless...Jesus rescues! Ephesians 1:19-20 “And what is the exceeding greatness of his power to us-ward who believe, according to the working of his mighty power, Which he wrought in Christ, when he raised him from the dead, and set him at his own right hand in the heavenly places”. The Bible in places describes our condition. We are described as being dead in trespasses and in sins, not just badly injured. Friends, dead men don't do! They are powerless! But Romans 5:6 teaches us that “...when we were yet without strength, in due time Christ died for the ungodly.” Jesus has come to our rescue.

God help us that in whatever situation we might find ourselves in we look to our rescuer. His name is Jesus, the same rescuer that dealt with Daniel, with David, with Joseph, with Paul and who leads and guides each of us.
