In Luke 20:13 we find these words, "Then said the lord of the vineyard, What shall I do? I will send my beloved son: it may be they will reverence him when they see him." I don't have the power to reveal Jesus to you, but the Holy Spirit within you has the power to let you see him and "may be" you "will reverence him when" you "see him." Maybe that will happen to you today, maybe it won't. There has been a lot more irreverence throughout history than there has been reverence. And it would seem that in our nation today there is a lot more apathy and unconcern than there is irreverence or reverence.

What is your reaction to that son? Have you heard so much about him that the whole story has become sort of second nature? Are you excited to hear another story about him?

In those days when Luke was inspired by God to write these words, they were blessed to see the wonder of this son, they really saw this son in his greatness and there are words in the scripture that describe their reactions. They "marvelled" at him, they "wondered" at him. They were "amazed" at him and they were "astonished" at him. Are those our reactions today? Are we amazed by his grace? Are we amazed at the Grace of the Father that he would send his beloved son into the middle of a wicked world? Is that amazing or is it getting boring?

The Bible tells us in places they "were beyond measure astonished". (Mark 7:37) When Jesus brought life back into that little twelve year old girl, it says "they were astonished with a great astonishment." (Mark 5:42) They couldn't say it any better, so they said it twice. "May be they'll reverence him" and some did.

Marvel at that son, be astonished at his presence, they were. In all of the amazements that the son brought with him, in all of the things that he did that caused people to wonder and to marvel, none of these acts can compare in amazement to what the Father had planned when he said "What shall I do? I will send my beloved son." That is amazing, that was the decision made before the foundation of the world, "I will send my beloved son."

He did not send his son in response to any goodness that he saw, any request that came, any love in the hearts of any who were here for him. He sent his son in response to sin. He looked down in that vineyard in that parable and he saw that they had rejected him over and over and he said "What shall I do? I will send my beloved son" in response to that sin.

If God has made you to know him, don't return to the sins of this world, but grow closer and see him clearer. Do you know him, then "reverence" him, obey him, pray to him, worship him, profess your knowledge of Him, be baptized, and serve in a church with others who are amazed! Be amazed! May God Bless You to reverence that beloved son!
