Mitchell Calvin is looking into Internet Service for the Church.


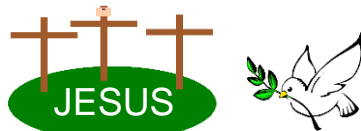
Brenda Austin & Bonita Lenger will represent Goshen at the PB Conference in Alabama April 29-30.
